TRANSPORTERS OF RCRA HAZARDOUS WASTE

- ◆ Transporters of RCRA hazardous waste must obtain a RCRA Hazardous Waste ID number. An EPA Notification of Regulated Waste Activity form 8700-12 (Subtitle C Site ID form) should be filed to obtain this number. Go to the address below for further information.

- ◆ If the transporter already has a valid RCRA ID number from another state, that number is good in Indiana and no further ID numbers are required to haul hazardous waste to, from, or through Indiana.
- ◆ Each shipment of RCRA hazardous waste must be accompanied by a valid uniform hazardous waste manifest. Go to the address below for further information.

- ◆ The transporter must adhere to all regulations as set forth in Indiana regulations 329 IAC 3.1 Rule 8 which adopts federal regulations 40 CFR 263.

TRANSPORTERS OF USED OIL

- ◆ Transporters of used oil must obtain a RCRA Hazardous Waste ID number. An EPA Notification of Regulated Waste Activity form 8700-12 (Subtitle C Site ID form) should be filed to obtain this number. Go to the address below for further information. www.in.gov/idem/5029.htm.
- ◆ The transporter must adhere to all regulations as set forth in Indiana regulations 329 IAC 13.

TRANSPORTERS OF UNIVERSAL WASTE

- ◆ Transporters of universal waste must adhere to all regulations as set forth in Indiana regulations 329 IAC 3.1 Rule 16 which adopts federal regulations 40 CFR 273.

- ◆ Universal waste transporters are not required to obtain a RCRA ID number.

HAZARDOUS WASTE TRANSFER FACILITIES

- ◆ Businesses who mix, combine, commingle, bulk, repackage, pump, transfer, or open hazardous waste during transport submit a notification to IDEM. <http://www.in.gov/idem/5033.htm>
- ◆ And comply with the regulations set forth in 329 IAC 3.1-8-4.

SEPTAGE HAULERS

All businesses that remove and manage septic wastewater from domestic septic tanks, holding tanks, privies, seepage pits, cesspools, compost toilets, portable sanitary units and "restaurant" grease (animal/vegetable only) from traps or interceptors must have a permit. All vehicles used to transport septic wastewater must have a valid vehicle license. The regulation and rule governing Wastewater Management can be found at IC 13-18-12 and 327 IAC 7.1 [PDF file]. There are no fees for the business permit, vehicle license, and storage/treatment permit, however, there is a fee for land application site approvals.

TIRE TRANSPORTERS

A person who transports waste tires in Indiana shall register with the Department as a waste tire transporter, hold a valid certificate of registration issued under 329 IAC 15-4-1, comply with the conditions in the certificate of registration, and prepare a manifest (per 329 IAC 15-4-13) for each load of waste tires, providing a copy of the completed manifest to the waste tire generator and the waste tire storage site or waste tire processing operation that receives the waste tires.

PCB TRANSPORTERS

PCBs are regulated under federal rules 40 CFR 761. Indiana incorporated most of the language found in the federal rules. Anyone who generates, commercial stores, transports, or disposes (*landfills, incinerators, etc.*) must submit a "Notification of PCB Waste Activities" form (EPA Form 7710-53) and obtain an EPA ID number. The US EPA will respond by either issuing a number or send a letter indicating you may use an existing EPA ID. Then you may transport PCB waste. The IDEM is not authorized (as is no other state) to handle this registration for you. Specific information about PCBs, including this Form, can be found at www.epa.gov/pcbs.
